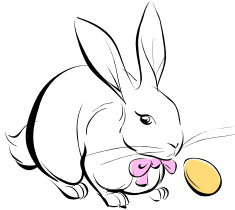

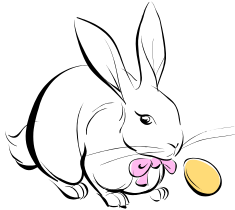

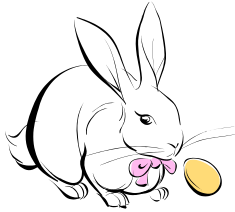
**** We are looking for more collection points both in the UK and abroad. If you feel you will be able to help please let me know.**
