I am not vain but I have to say that this has really affected me. With all the cancers I have suffered from in the past I was able to hide them from the world but now it is in plain sight for all to see and it has really knocked my confidence. But the love of my family and friends and all you lovely knitters has kicked me back into shape and I am even more determined to get on and complete the scarf.

I have had cancer 3 times now so I try to live life to the full. You never know when this terrible disease will rear its ugly head again. So here's to beating this disease into shape...
